Eligibility Criteria

1. Member of NEOCNS
2. Preferred but not required, member of the National Association of Clinical Nurse Specialists (NACNS)
3. The nominee must have 5 years of experience as a CNS
4. The nominee must serve as a role model to nursing colleagues. The nominator will describe the nominee in the following areas:

Describe how the nominee:

- a. Demonstrates CNS competencies and exemplary practice in patient care, nursing, and health care delivery

- b. Has influenced nursing practice with evidenced based practice and/or research
- c. Disseminates knowledge through presentations and publications
- d. Has impacted the NEOCNS chapter
- e. Embodies leadership and influences innovative nursing practice which improves a patient's quality of life

Award

The award will be presented at the NEOCNS Fall Conference. The winner will be featured on the NEOCNS website and Facebook page.

Selection

Applications received by the deadline will undergo review by the selection committee appointed by the steering committee. The recipient will be informed of winning the award at the NEOCNS Fall Conference. The application deadline will be strictly enforced.

Instructions

1. The nominee or nominator should provide information supporting the nomination relating to the specific criteria of the award.
2. All submissions must be typed.
3. The nominee's name should not appear anywhere in the body of the material submitted, including the header or footer. The nominee's name should appear only on a separate cover page.
4. Letters of recommendation are not required but can be helpful to the selection committee. The nominee's name must not appear in the recommendation letter. All information will remain strictly confidential and will not be returned.
5. Selection is made based solely on the information submitted.
